

## Granby Public Schools Nondiscrimination Policy

It is the policy of the Granby Board of Education to forbid acts of discrimination in all matters dealing with employees and students. The right of a student to participate fully in the educational system shall not be abridged or impaired. You may not be denied the right to participate in a publically funded educational setting based on the following protected classes: *race, color, religion, gender, gender identification or expression, national origin, age, disability, marital status, pregnancy, and/or genetic information*. If you are a **student**, you may not be discriminated against in the following areas: admission; use of school facilities; vocational education; competitive activities; student rules, regulations and benefits; financial assistance; school-sponsored extracurricular activities; enrollment in courses; counseling and guidance; physical education; graduation requirements; treatment as a married and/or pregnant student health services; and most other aid, benefits or services.
