To All Parents, Guardians and Staff Members:

Text messaging capability is available through SchoolMessenger, the system we use for emergency-related notifications. If you have not already done so and decide to sign up for the texting feature, please be advised that you will receive a phone call and a text message in emergency situations. You will also now have the ability to receive a text message for weather-related school cancellations, late openings and early releases.

Please read the following instructions carefully:

In order to participate in the service, you must indicate your willingness to receive text messages to your phone. The process is simple and only takes a few seconds to complete. Up to two cell phones can receive text messages. Please note: If you have updated your back-to-school forms, it is not necessary to contact the main office your child(ren) attend; however, you will need to contact the school(s) if you need to update or add cell phone information.

To begin receiving this service text the word **Yes** to the number **68453**.

You may cancel out of the service at any time by texting the word **STOP** to the number **68453**. **Please note:** You may begin or restart the service at any time by texting the word **Yes** to the number **68453**.

You will know you were successful in signing up when you receive the following reply message:

You are now registered with the SchoolMessenger notification service. Reply STOP to cancel, HELP for help. Msg&data rates may apply. 3 msgs/mo. Schoolmessenger.com/tm

Although the district does not charge you for this service, data charges may be incurred through your wireless carrier. Check with your wireless carrier for possible charges.
